The American Association for the Surgery of Trauma has once again partnered with Genigraphics to provide poster session services for this year's meeting. Poster Format Requirements

- Poster files must be set to **24" tall by 48" wide**.
- A section at the top of the poster must contain the Title, Authors, and Affiliations.
- Poster content should be easily read from a distance of 4-5 feet.
- Files must be in PowerPoint (.ppt or .pptx) or Adobe Acrobat (.pdf) file format.
- Files should be no more than 5MB in size. Contact Genigraphics support if this is an issue.

All Poster Presenters are required to upload their files for the online ePoster session

Participation is free and the process only takes a few minutes. The ePosters will be available for viewing beginning Wednesday, September 18, 2019 and will remain available after the meeting as part of the permanent archive. ***There will be no printed posters at this year's meeting.***
