Thank you for your interest in the American Association for the Surgery of Trauma Research and Education Foundation. The AAST Foundation provides medical students, residents and in-training fellows scholarships to attend the Annual Meeting of AAST and Clinical Congress of Acute Care Surgery.

**Eligibility and Requirements:** 

- Applicants must be sponsored by an AAST member.
- Applications MUST include ALL of the following items: cover letter, CV and letter of sponsorship from an AAST member.
- All cover letters and letters of sponsorship must be addressed to Dr. Martin A. Croce, AAST Secretary-Treasurer (address below).
- All applications must be received by 11:59 p.m. central time on Monday, June 1, 2015
- Incomplete and late applications will not be considered

This year's Annual Meeting will be held September 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> at the Wynn Las Vegas in Las Vegas, NV. If awarded, the scholarship will cover: registration fee for the meeting and the cost of hotel room for four nights (Tuesday, September 8th- Saturday, September 12th). In addition, you will be provided with a \$200 stipend for meals/misc. items (\$50/per day).
